TAB 4 - LOCAL POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS - LOANS

3. **L08-444 - Ascension Parish, City of Donaldsonville** - Not exceeding \$2,000,000 Certificates of Indebtedness, not exceeding 6%, maturing on or before November 1, 2009, paying the cost of storm related services, repairs and replacements.
4. **L08-439 - Calcasieu Parish Police Jury** - Not exceeding \$250,000 Excess Revenue Loan, interest rate not exceeding the 3-month LIBOR plus 300 basis points, not exceeding 9%, maturing no more than 2 years, paying a portion of the costs of construction of 3 single family affordable housing units at the corner of North Grace and Moeling Streets in the City of Lake Charles.
5. **L08-435 - Franklin Parish Fire Protection District No. 2** - Not exceeding \$86,024 Excess Revenue Loan, interest rate not exceeding 4.625%, not exceeding 10 years, acquiring and purchasing a fire truck and other fire fighting equipment.
6. **L08-438 - Rapides Parish Police Jury, Fire Protection District No. 7** - Not exceeding \$200,000 Limited Tax Certificates of Indebtedness, not exceeding 6%, maturing no later than March 1, 2018, constructing fire protection facilities.
7. **L08-446 - St. Mary Parish Law Enforcement District** - Not exceeding \$1,000,000 Revenue Anticipation Note, not exceeding 6%, maturing no later than June 30, 2009, to pay operating costs and unanticipated emergency expenses incurred because of Hurricanes Gustav and Ike.

13. **L08-440 - Rapides Parish, Sewerage District No. 1** - (1) Not exceeding \$353,000 Sewer Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 3.625%, not exceeding 40 years, constructing and acquiring additions, extensions and improvements to the sewerage system, including equipment, accessories and properties; (2) not exceeding \$353,000 Bond Anticipation Notes, not exceeding 6%, not exceeding 18 months, providing interim financing for the proposed project; and (3) approval of the Notice of Intention.
14. **L08-441 - Washington Parish School Board, Varnado School District** - Not exceeding \$790,000 General Obligation School Refunding Bonds, not exceeding 4%, and maturing March 1 of each year with a final maturity of March 1, 2018, refunding of the Issuer's outstanding General Obligation School Bonds, Series 1998.

17. **S08-051 - Louisiana Community Development Authority (Mary Bird Perkins Cancer Center II Project)** - Not exceeding \$10,000,000 Lease Revenue Bonds, at a fixed rate not exceeding 6% and maturing no later than 7 years, financing the acquisition of a new linear accelerator, refinance existing debt and acquire new cancer treatment centers.

22. **S08-048A - Jefferson Parish Finance Authority** - Not exceeding \$30,000,000 Single Family Mortgage Revenue Bonds, Series 2008B, not exceeding 7.00%, not exceeding 42 years, (i) finance the purchase of mortgage loans and/or mortgage-backed securities issued by FNMA, FHLMC or GNMA with respect to mortgage loans on owner-occupied residential immovable property owned by low and moderate income persons in the Parish of Jefferson to be originated by participating mortgage lenders; (ii) refund, if necessary, certain outstanding obligations of the Authority; (iii) make deposits into certain funds as may be required to secure the Series 2008B Bonds and successfully market the Series 2008B Bonds; and (iv) pay capitalized interest, if any on the Series 2008B Bonds.
