2. Approval of the minutes of the January 22, 2008 meeting.

**TAB 4 - LOCAL POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS - LOANS**

3. **L08-043 - Allen Parish Police Jury, Road District No. 5** - Not exceeding \$68,500 Anticipation of Avails Certificates of Indebtedness, 3.90%, maturing on March 1 of 2009-2011, purchasing equipment for improving and maintaining Parish roads and bridges.
4. **L08-052 - Calcasieu Parish, City of Sulphur** - Not exceeding \$324,300 Paving Certificates, not exceeding 8%, maturing annually over a period not to exceed 10 years from date of issuance, construction of improvements to various streets (Chestnut, Acadianne, Gabriel, Augustine and Driftwood Streets) within the City of Sulphur.
5. **L08-051 - LaSalle Parish, Hospital Service District No. 1** - Not exceeding \$800,000 Certificates of Indebtedness, not exceeding 6%, maturing on March 1, 2009, paying current expenses for the year ending December 31, 2008.
6. **L08-061 - Rapides Parish, City of Pineville (Lowe's Home Centers, Inc. Project)** - Not exceeding \$2,000,000 Certificates of Indebtedness, 0% interest, not exceeding 10 years, acquisition and installation of a Lowe's Home Centers, Inc. facility within the City of Pineville.
7. **L08-063 - St. Helena Parish, Hospital Service District No. 1** - Not exceeding \$2,100,000 Budgetary Loan, not exceeding 6%, maturing no later than March 1, 2009, current expenses.
8. **L08-064 - Union Parish Police Jury** - Not exceeding \$4,039,000 Standby Irrevocable Letter of Credit, not exceeding 0% interest, not exceeding 1 year, closure costs and post-closure costs of the Parish Landfill in Union Parish and a Note or other evidence of indebtedness, not exceeding \$4,039,000, not exceeding 6%, not exceeding 1 year, to represent the Issuer's obligation to repay any funds drawn upon the Letter of Credit.
9. **L07-531 - Webster Parish, Town of Cullen** - Not exceeding \$450,405 Excess Revenue Certificates of Indebtedness, 5%, maturing on March 1, 2009, not exceeding 10 years, paying the costs of constructing a building to be used as a dialysis center and acquiring equipment and furnishings.

11. **L07-511A - Calcasieu Parish, Waterworks District No. 14 of Ward 5** - Not exceeding \$2,599,000 Water Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 5%, not exceeding 40 years, acquisition and establishment of additions to and improvements of the waterworks system for and within the District.
  12. **L07-478A - Lincoln Parish, Town of Grambling** - Not exceeding \$933,000 Sewer Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 4.38%, not exceeding 40 years, financing the constructing and acquiring improvements, extensions and replacements to the sewer system, including appurtenant equipment, accessories and properties.

  14. **L08-058 - Red River Parish School Board, Parishwide School District No. 1** - Not exceeding \$8,000,000 General Obligation School Refunding Bonds, not exceeding 4.5%, maturing serially not later than March 1, 2018, refunding all or any portion of the Issuer's outstanding General Obligation School Bonds, Series 1998 and General Obligation School Bonds, Series 1999
  15. **L08-060 - St. Bernard Parish Council** - Not exceeding \$7,000,000 Sales Tax Refunding Bonds, not exceeding 5%, maturing December 1, 2010 through December 1, 2019, refunding the Issuer's outstanding Sales Tax Bonds, Series 1999 maturing December 1, 2010 though December 1, 2019.
  16. **L08-044 - St. Landry Parish, Town of Leonville** - Not exceeding \$220,000 Revenue Bonds, Series 2008, not exceeding 5%, not exceeding 15 years, to construct and acquire improvements, extensions and replacements to the waterworks system, including equipment, accessories and properties.
  17. **L08-045 - Tensas Parish, Lake Bruin Waterworks District No. 1** - Not exceeding \$100,000 Water Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 5%, not exceeding 10 years, paying costs of constructing and acquiring improvements and extensions to the waterworks system, including appurtenant equipment, accessories and properties, both personal and real.

  19. **L07-245A - Vermilion Parish, Hospital Service District No. 2** - (1) Not exceeding \$2,500,000 Hospital Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 25 years, not exceeding 4.125%, constructing improvements to the Abbeville General Hospital, and acquiring equipment; (2) Not exceeding \$2,500,000 Bond Anticipation Notes, not exceeding 4.5% per annum, not exceeding 2 years, providing interim financing.

20. **S08-006 - Louisiana Housing Finance Agency (Arbor Place Apartments Project)** - Not exceeding \$8,940,000 Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 12%, not exceeding 42 years, acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of a 136 unit residential rental facility serving low and moderate income families in Terrytown, Jefferson Parish.

21. **S07-111A - Louisiana Community Development Authority (Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission Project)** - Requesting additional approval of allowing the Port to enter into a floating (not exceeding 15%) to fixed rate (not exceeding 7%) swap in the future.
22. **S08-007 - Louisiana Community Development Authority (Cameron Parish, Louisiana Recovery Project)** - Not exceeding \$27,150,000 Revenue Bonds to be issued in multiple series as follows: (1) **Cameron Parish Police Jury** not exceeding \$16,500,000 for a term not exceeding 10 years, (2) **Cameron Parish Law Enforcement District** not exceeding \$4,200,000 for a term not exceeding 10 years, (3) **Cameron Parish Board of Library Control** not exceeding \$1,100,000 for a term not exceeding 10 years, (4) **Cameron Parish Mosquito Abatement District No. One** not exceeding \$4,800,000 for a term not exceeding 15 years, and (5) **Cameron Parish Assessment District** not exceeding \$550,000 for a term not exceeding 10 years, not exceeding 7%, (i) reconstruction, restoration and reestablishment of essential governmental infrastructure and facilities damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Rita on September 23-24, 2005, (ii) funding a debt service reserve fund; and (iii) paying the costs of issuance.

Project & 930 Poydras Apartments, L.L.C)** - Not exceeding \$45,000,000 Taxable Revenue Bonds for 930 Poydras Apartments LLC project and \$15,000,000 Taxable Revenue Bonds for 930 Poydras, LLC Parking Garage project, acquisition, construction and installation of a high-rise building with 251 apartments on top of a 509 space parking garage with retail space to be located at 930 Poydras Street.
25. **L08-054 - Industrial Development Board of the City of New Orleans, Louisiana, Inc. (2400 Canal, LLC)** - Not exceeding \$9,000,000 Revenue Bonds, financing the acquisition, construction and installation of a development project, consisting of the redevelopment of the Pan American Building into a retail and housing facility to provide housing to nurses, policemen, firemen and other first responders located at 2400 Canal Street.
26. **L08-055 - Industrial Development Board of the City of New Orleans, Louisiana, Inc. (New Orleans Federal Alliance and/or the Algiers Development District Project)** - Not exceeding \$150,000,000 Revenue Bonds, financing the acquisition, construction and equipping of a development project, for occupancy by federal and private sector agencies within the Federal City Complex at the Naval Support Activity located at 2300 General Meyer Avenue.

27. **L08-031A - Industrial Development Board of the City of New Orleans, Louisiana, Inc. (New Savoy Place Phase I Project)** - Not exceeding \$18,600,000 Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 12%, not exceeding 40 years, construction and installation of a development project consisting of 158 mixed-income, rental units of single-family homes and duplexes as well as a community building located in the Upper Ninth Ward of eastern New Orleans.

28. **S08-002A - Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (American Sugar Refining, Inc. Project)** - Not exceeding \$30,000,000 Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 15% variable rate or 8% fixed rate, not exceeding 30 years, construction, acquisition, installation and equipping an expansion to its existing refinery in St. Bernard Parish, including the construction of a molasses blending plant and a pilot plant regarding the rehabilitation of spent calcium carbonate.

29. **S08-008 - Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (Comm-Care Louisiana Project)** – Preliminary approval for not exceeding \$70,000,000 Revenue and Refunding Bonds, (i) finance the acquisition, construction and equipping of three replacement nursing facilities to be located in East Baton Rouge Parish, Avoyelles Parish and Ouachita Parish; (ii) reimburse the Corporation an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 for prior expenditures for land acquisition and Project costs related to such facilities; (iii) refund all of the outstanding Extended Care Facilities Revenue Bonds (Comm-Care Corporation Project) Series 1994; (iv) acquire, from a wholly-owned non-profit subsidiary corporation, four existing nursing facilities located in East Baton Rouge, St. Tammany and St. James Parishes; and (v) to fund a debt service reserve for the Bonds.
